AND IN THE MATTER OF:

Directions upon the Respondents to take appropriate steps for shifting Deeds/ Documents/Records and Balam/Volume Books prior to 1970 from the District Registrar Office, Pabna to the District Registrar Office, Sirajgonj.

<u>GROUNDS:</u>

I. For that as per the provisions of the Registration Act 1908, every Sub-Registrar of each District Sadar is under obligation to give a certified copy of Deeds/documents of his/her District. But in case of Sirajgonj District, the provisions of law are not followed by the respondents in respect of the Deeds/documents/records which are dated back prior to 1970 because they are kept in Pabna District Registry. Hence, direction may be given upon the respondents to shift the said Deeds/documents/records from Pabna District Registrar Office to Sirajgonj District Registry Office.

II. For that as per the provisions of the Constitution, every citizen will get equal protection of law and they will not be discriminated in any way. But the common people of Sirajgonj do not enjoy their rights equally. They have to go to Pabna District Registry Office for collection of certified copies or for any search of any documents/deeds which date back the year of 1970 and they have to spend a lot in that behalf. Hence, they are discriminated, which is illegal. So, direction may be given upon the respondents to shift the

said Deeds/documents/records from Pabna District Registrar Office to Sirajgonj District Registry Office.

III. For that the unavailability of the Deeds/documents/records and the Balam/Volume Books in Sirajgonj, which are dated back the year of 1970 and kept laying in Pabna, ultimately, causes delay and make complicacy in disposal of civil suits in Sirajgonj, which frustrates the administration of justice in grass root. Those documents/records are also being destroyed due to negligence of the respondents and that of heir indifference as well.

IV. For that of late new buildings for the Sirajgonj District Registry Office and the Sirajgonj Sub-Registry Office has been built making huge accommodation in Sirajgonj District Registry Office and the Sirajgonj Sub-Registry Office for keeping the files/Deeds/documents and Balam/Volume Books. Hence, the respondents are under obligation to bring them back in Sirajgonj for protection of the interest and benefits of the common people of Sirajgonj as well as to perform their duties in line with the provisions of law. Hence, direction may be given to shift the said Deeds/documents/records from Pabna District Registrar Office to Sirajgonj District Registry Office.

V. For that the duty and responsibility vested upon the respondents is to serve the people as per the provisions of law. But the respondents have failed to perform the duties and responsibility as well as failed to protect the rights of the common people, which is illegal. Hence, direction may be passed for shifting the said govt. records and deeds/documents from Pabna to Sirajgonj.

> Wherefore, it is most humbly prayed that Your Lordships would graciously be pleased to;-

> Issue a Rule Nisi calling upon the a) Respondents to show cause as to why the failure/inaction of the respondents to take appropriate steps for shifting Deeds Documents / Records and Balam/Volume Books prior to 1970 from the District Registrar Office, Pabna to the District Registrar Office, Sirajgonj, should not be declared illegal and without lawful authority.

b) Direct the office to serve notices upon the respondents at the cost of the office.

c) Upon hearing the causes if any shown make the rule absolute.

d) Pass such other or further order or orders as Your Lordships may deem fit and proper.

Present Status

The case was filled and moved by Advocate Manzill Murshid, President, HRPB. After hearing the parties the Hon'ble Court issued Rule Nisi upon the respondents and granted ad-interim order. The matter is pending before the Hon'ble High Court Division.
